United Way of the Alberta Capital Region has been a proud supporter of the people of the City of Leduc & Leduc County since 2005.

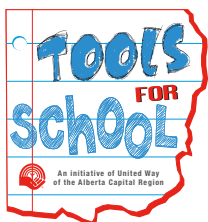
United Way provides \$66,616 to the **Leduc & District Food Bank** to support its hamper program and Learning Centre Kitchen program. The Leduc & District Food Bank serves clients from Beaumont, Calmar, Devon, City of Leduc, Leduc County, New Sarepta, Nisku, Thorsby, and Warburg.

United Way provides \$77,020 to **Leduc Boys & Girls Club** Out of School Program and Healthy Boys, Healthy Girls Programs. The club offers a safe, supportive environment to children ages 6-17.

United Way gives the **Leduc Housing Foundation** \$15,000 for its Emergency Response Fund, which helps people meet their housing needs or avoid eviction.

## DID YOU KNOW?

In 2015, 3,554 people who participated in United Way of the Alberta Capital Region programs reported they live in Leduc or Leduc County.



**United Way's Tools for School** program provided 331 backpacks filled with school supplies for distribution through the Leduc Food Bank in 2016. Students whose families have limited resources started off the school year with the tools for success.

**HISTORY** - On September 11th, 2014, mayors of Leduc County and its municipalities partnered with United Way to help create pathways out of poverty.



The mayors signed their names to a banner in a pledge of support for the work of the United Way.

Shortly after came the creation of the **Leduc Caring Companies**. The vision of the Caring Companies is to engage and connect the Leduc Regional Business community and focus collective efforts on creating pathways out of poverty.

## NEW IN 2017

United Way is now supporting two new local agencies:

- **Riseup Society of Alberta**, a Leduc-based organization dedicated to supporting those impacted by domestic abuse.
- **Society of Saint Vincent de Paul**, a lay Catholic organization based at St. Michael's Parish in Leduc.
